

JUDICIAL LAW CLERK OPENING – JANUARY 2019

Judge Susan L. Kelsey is accepting applications for a judicial law clerk to start full-time employment the first week of January, 2019. Applicants must demonstrate excellent academic credentials and superior skills in writing and grammar, as well as the ability to synthesize complex factual and legal issues quickly and succinctly. A two-year commitment is requested but can be waived for extraordinary applicants.

Starting salary for lawyers who have not yet passed the Florida Bar is \$41,235.48, with an increase to \$45,817.20 upon passing the Florida Bar. Subject to the Chief Judge's approval, lawyers with at least two years of experience may start as a Senior Law Clerk at a salary of \$53,585.76, with an additional 10% increase available upon approval for lawyers with three years' experience.

Applicants must provide a cover letter, current resume, recent writing sample, evidence of law school grades, class rank, and completed State of Florida job application.
