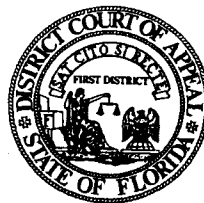


In re: Electronic Filing following Hurricane Michael

This Court's Administrative Order 10-4, required all attorneys appearing before this Court to register as users with eDCA and required all registered users to file all documents electronically through eDCA. In recognition of the widespread electrical and internet outages in Bay, Calhoun, Franklin, Gadsden, Gulf, Holmes, Jackson, Liberty, Taylor, Wakulla, and Washington Counties, registered users in those counties who are without internet access are temporarily excused from the requirement to file all pleadings electronically through eDCA. Unless otherwise directed, parties and attorneys located in the above listed counties who lack internet access may file documents in paper format. Documents must include a certification that the filer lacks internet access and be hand-delivered or postmarked by November 14, 2018. This administrative order does not affect the due date of any filings.
